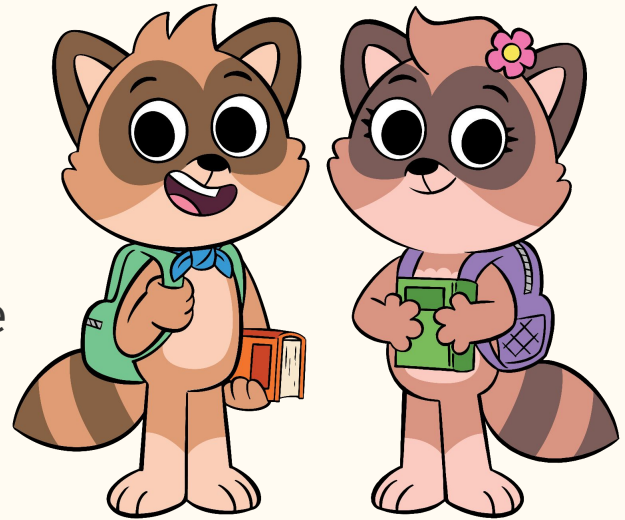

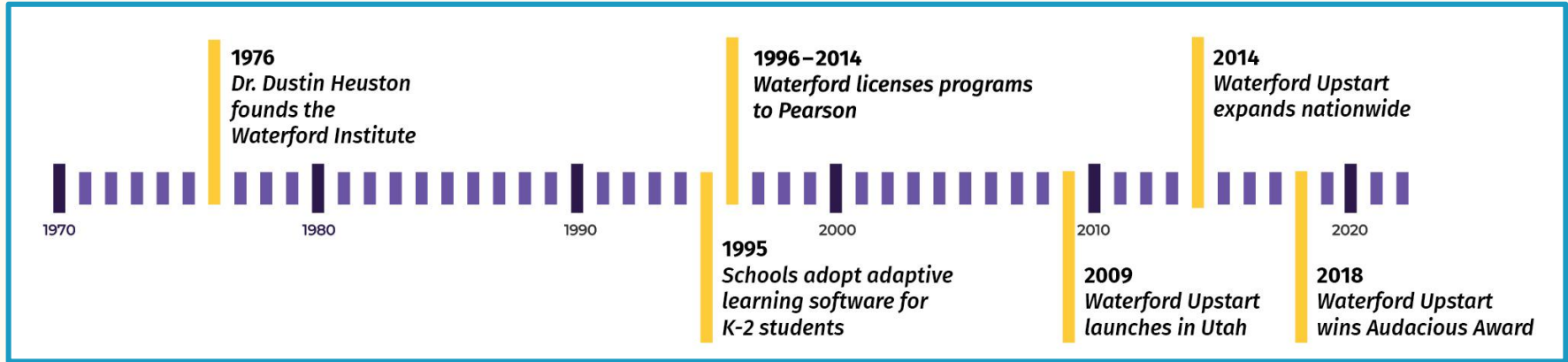
Mission & Values

- Technology access

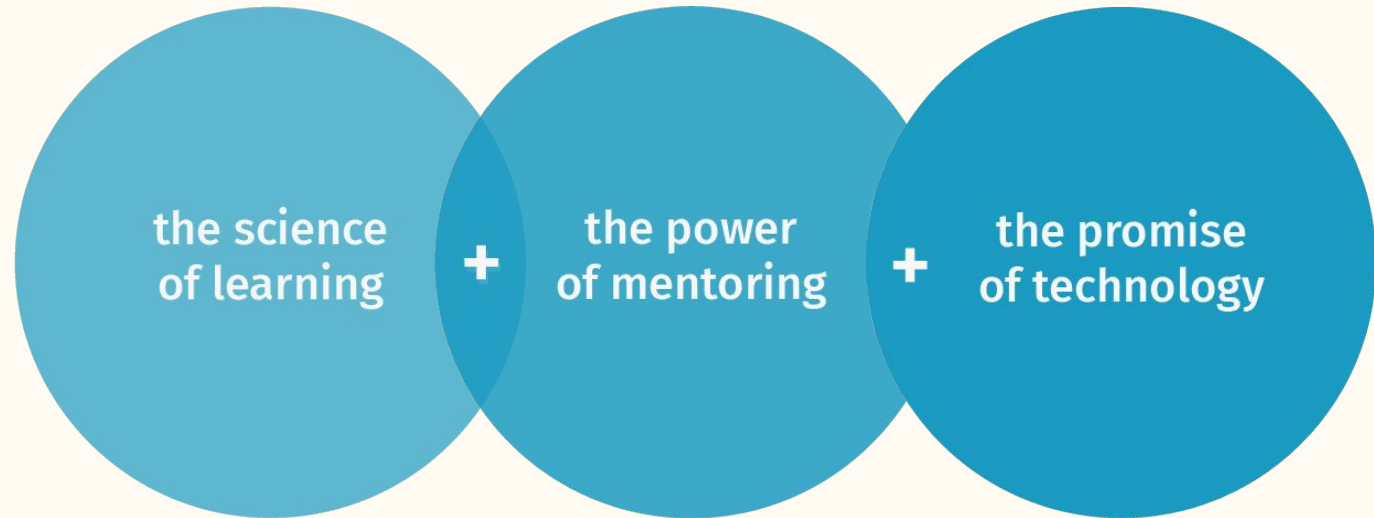

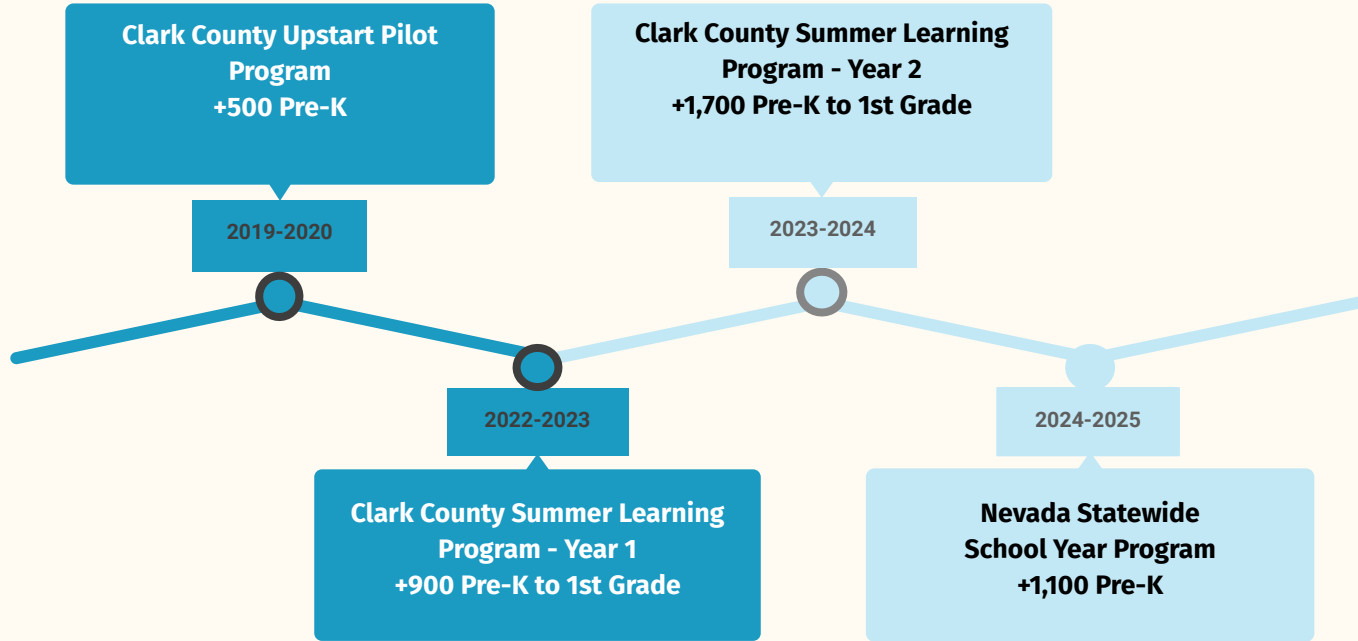
We provide Pre K through 2nd grade reading, math, and science programs that children can use wherever they learn.

Research & Success Stories

Clark County Upstart Pilot Program

Approximately 500 preschool-age children from Clark County participated in the pilot during the 2019-2020 school year.

- Over 40% of participating children were English Language Learners; and
- Approximately 80% of participating children were from families under 200% of the federal poverty level.

Reading Program Outcomes:

Children's outcomes averaged at the "Kindergarten Intermediate" level, where most children score mid-point during the Kindergarten year.

80.26% of children scored at "Kindergarten Beginning" or above, demonstrating strong school readiness outcomes.

Children from low-income families (under 200% of the federal poverty level) demonstrated higher point gains than their more affluent peers

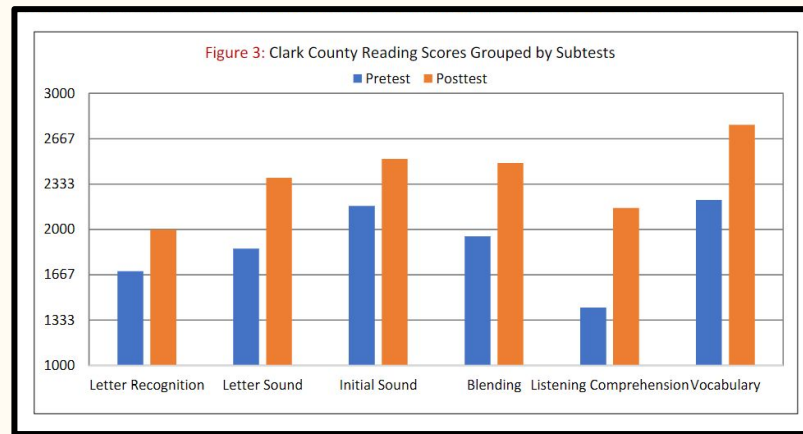


Figure 3 shows average results for WACS pretest and posttest scores, grouped by subtests for the program

Coaching provides families with ideas, encouragement, and guidance on how to create a nurturing at-home learning environment, build consistent routines, and develop positive mindset skills in their children. English and Spanish-speaking coaches are available through Waterford and Waterford partners with translation services to ensure all families have access to expert coaching.

Waterford Family Academy workshops provide families with opportunities to learn more about the academic content their child is learning in the classroom and why it's important. 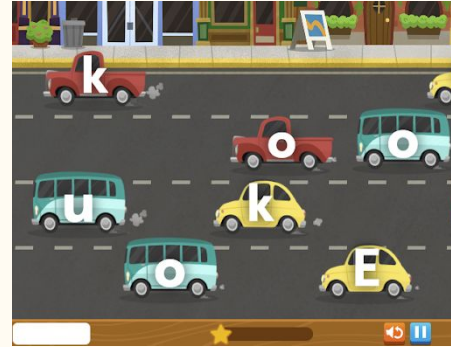

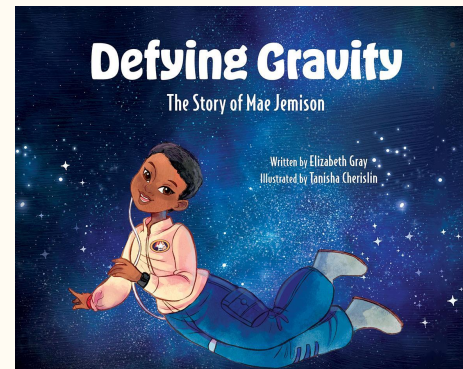
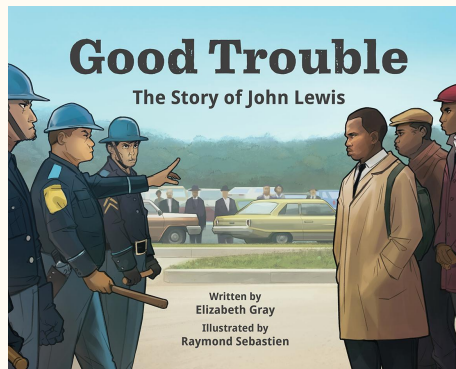
